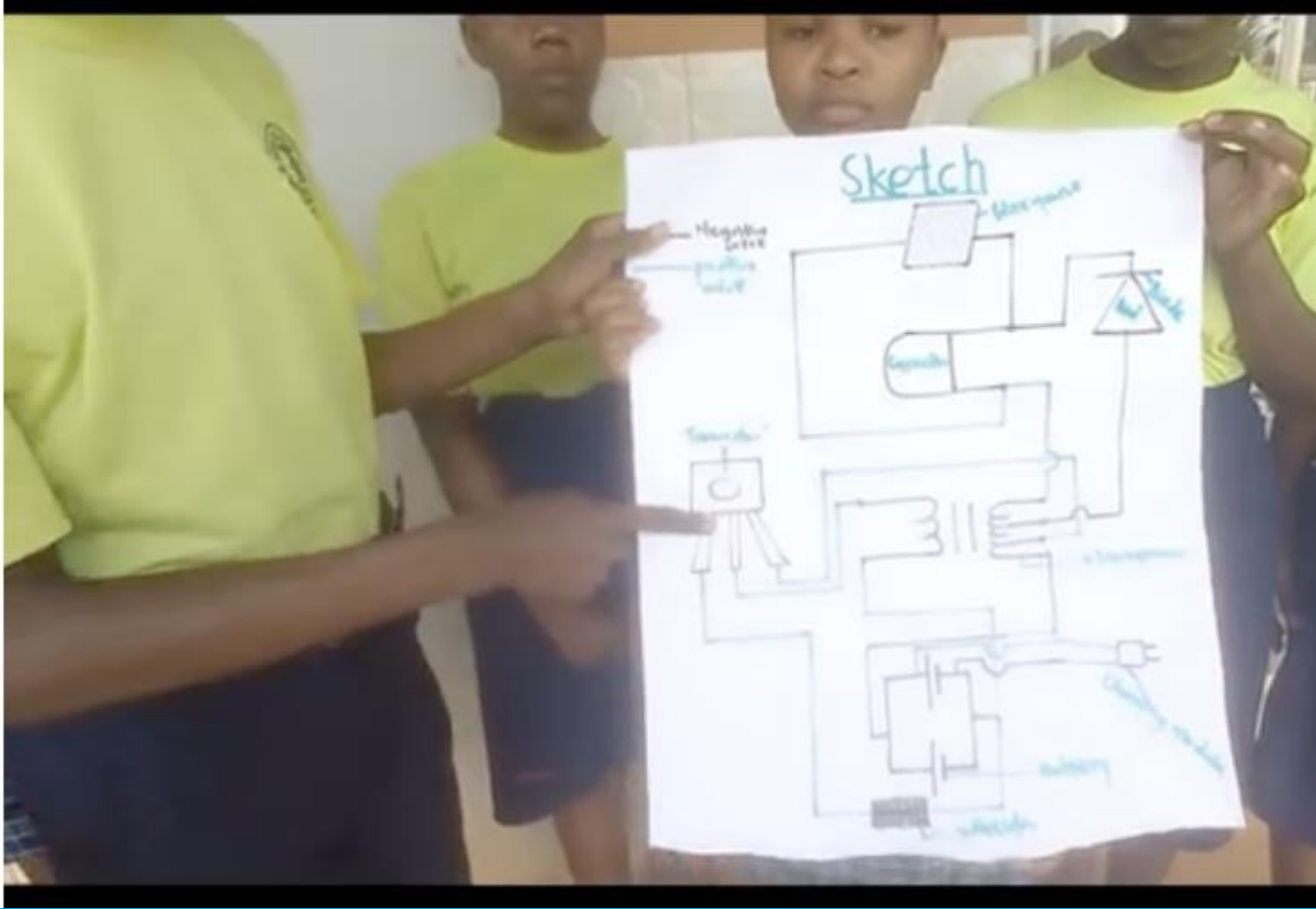

**RE: REQUEST FOR HUMPS, SIGNPOSTS AND A ZEBRA CROSSING TO BE PROVIDED
MAKING THE TARMAC ROAD SAFER FOR THE CHILDREN OF THE OMWAANA
TUGENDE CHILDREN'S HOME**

Dear Sir,

Omwaana Tugende Children's Home is the only Home for vulnerable children in Kakumiro District registered with the Ministry of Gender Labour and Social Development. It is situated on the tarmac road between Igayaza and Birembo and supported by Adelante Africa Tugende Omumaiso Uganda.

The Home is on a curve, and this constitutes considerable danger for the children crossing the road as vehicles moving at speed may not have time to stop.

Moreover, ten metres before the gates of the Home is a signpost authorising drivers to increase their speed to 70 kms an hour. Please see attached photos.

We would be most grateful if you could use your influence to get the company responsible for making the road to put humps and signposts indicating that there are children crossing on either side of the curve.

We would also be very grateful for a zebra crossing so children walking home from school (i.e. on the right side of the road) can cross to the left side, where the Home is located, in safety.

We hope that our request will be put to your consideration.
